

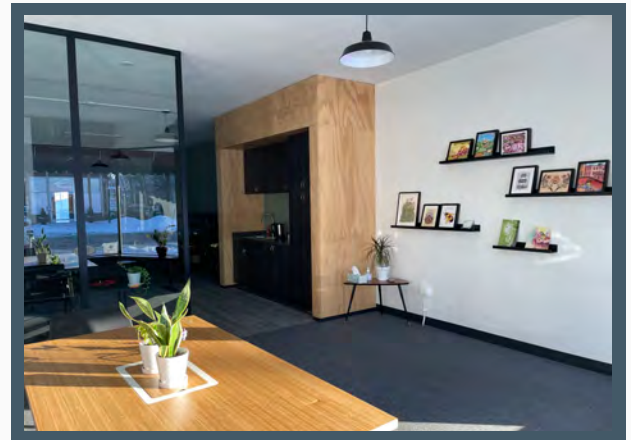


## Our New Home
