Summary:

Landcare crew members work in the maintenance of established naturalistic gardens of various sizes, completing garden maintenance tasks using sustainable techniques such as pulling, mowing, and smothering. Our crew members take pride in spending time with established gardens, pulling weeds, pruning plants, repairing erosion, and sustaining urban wildlife habitat in gardens and raingardens of various sizes across the Twin Cities. Landcare crew members may also assist with inspections and reporting of raingarden elements to meet reporting requirements.

How you'll spend your time:

1. Under the direction of the Sustainable Landcare Manager, you will work with a crew to maintain residential to institutional-sized landscape beds, native plantings, raingardens and other vegetated Green Stormwater Infrastructure
2. Work with other crew members to manage weedy plant species, maintain existing plantings, establish new vegetation, control erosion, and document maintenance activities
3. Utilize a wide variety of landscaping tools to complete landcare objectives, including hand tools, wheelbarrows, blowers, weed trimmers, brush cutter, and power tools
4. Plant trees, shrubs, forbs, grasses, seeds and other plant materials according to a plan
5. Complete garden maintenance tasks to a professional standard
6. Keep storage areas, equipment and vehicle clean and in good order throughout the season
7. Interact kindly and respectfully with other crew members, clients and members of the public, and Metro Blooms in a professional manner
8. Practice safe use of all tools and discuss safety guidelines for all work sites

Qualifications:

1. Willingness and desire to work as part of a team
2. Ability to complete tasks as they are assigned
3. Ability to communicate with the Sustainable Landcare Manager and crew members effectively
4. Ability to complete demanding physical work outside, in all weather conditions
5. A strong affinity for the outdoors and for working hard in the dirt
6. Interest in learning to identify native plants and common weeds
7. Ability to lift and carry up to 50 lbs
8. Ability to arrive to work on time and be available for 40 hours/week May-November
